



GOOD SHEPHERD CREATIVE PLAY 3-YEAR-OLD AND 4-YEAR-OLD CLASSES

Three- and four-year-old children's curiosity and desire to learn is encouraged and nurtured through classroom play and activities. We understand social interaction is a vital component of preschool. At Creative Play all children have the opportunity to learn through play. Children will learn important skills like critical thinking; problem solving; imaginary play and continued developing language along with developing their small and large motor skills. Children of these ages begin to develop greater independence, self-control, and personal creativity. We are here to not only support their personal needs but to encourage them to go beyond in a nurturing environment.

Below is some information about our 3- and 4-year-old programs:

- Class size approx. 16 students (varies slightly based on class)
- Parents are assigned workdays as a teacher's helper approximately 15 times throughout the school year (varies slightly based on class)
- Parents can choose to "opt out" of their workdays and pay a fee to cover their workdays.
- Each family serves on one committee.
- 4-year-old parents provide snack and beverage for their student daily
- 3-year-old snack is provided by the school
- Creative Play is an allergy aware school.
- The staff is First Aid & CPR certified.
- Building monitored by security cameras & door access control system.

3-Year-Old Classes:

The following classes are led by one teacher and two helping parents:

Mornings: Tuesday & Thursday 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Afternoons: Mon., Wed., & Fri., 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.

The following classes are led by one teacher, an aide & one helping parent:

Mornings: Mon., Wed., & Fri., 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Mornings: Monday – Friday 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m

4-Year-Old Classes:

The following classes are led by one teacher, an aide & one helping parent:
Mornings: Monday – Friday 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Afternoon 4-year-old classes will be developed based on the needs of the families.

All classes are based on meeting a required enrollment count.

FEES

- Registration fee: \$100.00 non-refundable fee is required.
- Bond: \$80.00 fee per family
Each family must post an \$80 bond to guarantee their participation in the program.
- Tuition is an annual fee; it may be broken into 10 monthly payments.
- Annual Tuition Fees:
 - 2-day program: \$2,500 annual tuition or \$250.00 a month
 - 3 hr. 3-day program: \$3,500 annual tuition or \$350.00 a month
 - 5-day program: \$4,200 annual tuition or \$420.00 a month
